RESOLUTION 2019-1**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF POST OAK BEND, TEXAS, ORDERING A GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON MAY 4, 2019, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING MAYOR AND TWO COUNCILMEMBERS BY THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE CITY OF POST OAK BEND, PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLICATION AND POSTING OF NOTICE, PROVIDING FOR EARLY VOTING; PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF ELECTION ADMINISTRATORS AND JUDGES; AND ESTABLISHING EARLY VOTING HOURS**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Post Oak Bend, Texas is a Type "A" General Law Municipality located in Kaufman, County, created in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Local Government Code and operating pursuant to the enabling legislation of the State of Texas: and

**WHEREAS**, Title 2A, Section 22.003 of the Local Government Code provides that an election for officers of Type "A" General Law Municipality shall be held annually on authorized uniform election day: and

**WHEREAS**, Section 41.001A (2) of the Texas Election Code, as amended by the 84th Texas Legislature, established the first Saturday of May, 2019, as a Uniform Election Day for the purposes of conducting a General Election; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 3.004b of the Texas Election Code provides that a governing body of a municipality shall be the authority to order a General Election for electing Municipal Officers; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED AND RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POST OAK BEND, TEXAS, THAT:**

**SECTION 1**

The City Council of the City of Post Oak Bend, Texas, hereby orders that a General Election be held on May 4, 2019, being the first Saturday in May of 2019, for the purpose of electing mayor and two councilmembers for two-year terms each.

**SECTION 2**


The election precinct for said election shall be the regular precinct of Kaufman County (Precinct 22) to the extent that they are within the corporate limits of the City of Post Oak Bend.

**SECTION 3**


The election shall be conducted pursuant to the election laws of the State of Texas.
