

ORDINANCE # 9

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE SURRENDER OF THE CITY OF Post Oak Bend ORIGINAL JURISDICTION OVER PUBLIC UTILITIES AS PROVIDED FOR IN THE PUBLIC UTILITY REGULATORY ACT TO THE PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION OF TEXAS.

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Post Oak Bend, being the 7th of August 1981 regularly assembled and open meeting after reasonable public notice and hearing considered its jurisdiction over public utilities as provided for in the Public Utility Regulatory Act; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Post Oak Bend is of the opinion that it should surrender its original jurisdiction to the Public Utility Commission of Texas;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF Post Oak Bend THAT ALL OF ITS ORIGINAL JURISDICTION OVER PUBLIC UTILITIES AS PROVIDED FOR IN THE PUBLIC UTILITY REGULATORY ACT BE SURRENDERED TO THE PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION OF TEXAS PURSUANT TO SECTION 17(b) OF THE PUBLIC UTILITY REGULATORY ACT.
